

# i-dott Annual Design Competition - All Years

What is involved in becoming a sponsor?

# Write the design brief:

Write the brief covering any design style or subject of your choosing. It needs to be focused and inspirational to encourage the student to express their talents. State the dimensions at which you want the student to work. Give more than one option for the student to select from.

The brief should be no more than 2 x A4 pages, and some imagery is always good. Any imagery that you do use needs to be copyright free as the briefs are published on our website and in our Yearbooks.

A good number of the colleges and universities are now embedding our competition into the course work for the winter term, therefore if you agreed to become a sponsor, we would need the design brief mid-July in the year prior to your year of sponsorship.

We can provide a brief writing service if you prefer.

### Take part in the final round of judging:

Once the shortlisting round is complete and the number of designs entered into the categories is edited, you will work with the other sponsors to make the final selection in all categories. When reviewing and placing the designs in the category sponsored by your company, you will be the Lead Judge and as such act as final Arbiter for your category.

### **Design Category Awards**

- Each of the winning students receives a certificate in recognition of their designs skills and can attract a MERIT if the work is executed to the dimensions specification asked for
- Each of the winning students will have their design printed as a wallpaper
- Each student receives a goody bag printed with details of the student's achievement, contents include a copy of the Yearbook, personalised notebooks and scarves printed in their designs. These are always popular as a keepsake. The other contents vary from year to year.



# Designs:

You will be given the opportunity to preview all the designs entered into the competition and given priority if you wish to buy any of the designs entered into the competition before these are made available to the wider membership and other interested parties.

#### Communication:

Your logo would appear in all publications and publicity connected with the competition.
